| Modification: | <p>Removed word “maximum” in reference to term of extended supervision because of potential eligibility for early release programs.</p> <p>Effective July 26, 2003, the court is to consider whether the defendant is eligible for either the Challenge Incarceration Program (Boot Camp) and/or the Earned Release Program. This program has been added to the Challenge Incarceration Program section of the form. Added related statute references §302.05(3)(a) and §973.01(3g).</p> |
