**Notice of Hearing -
 Temporary
 Restraining Order
 (Harassment)**

On the basis of the petition, the court finds reasonable grounds to believe that the respondent has engaged in harassment with intent to harass or intimidate the petitioner.

THE COURT ORDERS:

1. A hearing for an injunction be held:

2. The action may be commenced without payment of filing fees because the petition alleges conduct that is the same as or similar to conduct that is prohibited under §940.32; or is intentional infliction of physical pain, physical injury or illness; or is an intentional impairment of physical condition; or is a violation of §940.225(1),(2) or (3); or is a violation of §943.01 involving property that belongs to the individual; or is a threat to engage in the above mentioned conduct.

Until the hearing, **THE COURT FURTHER ORDERS:**

- 1. The respondent cease or avoid the harassment of petitioner.
- 2. The respondent avoid the residence and any premises temporarily occupied by the petitioner/victim.
- 3. The respondent is specifically prohibited from doing the following:

(Harassment is defined as: (a) Strikes, shoves, kicks or otherwise subjects the person to physical contact; engages in an act that would constitute abuse under §48.02(1); sexual assault under §940.225, or stalking under §940.32; or attempts or threatens to do same. (b) Engages in a course of conduct or repeatedly commits acts which harass or intimidate the person and which serve no legitimate purpose.)

THIS ORDER IS IN EFFECT UNTIL THE INJUNCTION HEARING IS HELD.

Violation of this order shall result in immediate arrest and is punishable by imprisonment not to exceed 90 days or a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or both, and payment of filing and services fees.
 If an injunction is issued, the judge or court commissioner may order the respondent not to possess a firearm while the injunction is in effect.
 This injunction is entitled to full faith and credit in every civil or criminal court of the United States or any other state, or Indian tribal courts (to the extent such tribal courts have personal jurisdiction over non tribal members).
