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**Name of Form:** Injunction (Harassment)

**Purpose of Form:** Formal document granting injunction

**Who Completes It:** Judge or Court Commissioner

**Distribution of Form:** Original to court file, copies to parties, copy to law enforcement agency acting as repository for injunctions, copy to Department of Justice *if the firearms restriction has been ordered.*

**Accompanying Forms:** None

**New Form/Modification:** Modification, last update 10/05.

**Modifications:** Added in the "Court Finds" section under #3 "There are reasonable grounds to believe that the respondent has engaged in harassment with intent to harass or intimidate the petitioner." This was added to comply with 2005 WI Act 272.

**Comment:** There is no filing fee if the form of harassment is the type of behavior noted under (a) of the new definition of harassment. There is a filing fee if the form of harassment is the type of behavior noted under (b) of the new definition of harassment.

These orders now can remain in effect for four years.

The firearm prohibition is discretionary with the judge in a harassment petition. This is different from a domestic abuse or child abuse injunction in which the firearm prohibition is **mandatory**.

Can be used for juvenile proceedings.
