**STIPULATION TO CONVERT LEGAL SEPARATION
TO DIVORCE JUDGMENT**

ORDER

1. The judgment of legal separation is converted to a judgment of divorce.
2. Any party may resume the use of a former legal surname approved in the **Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Judgment** or as requested in this stipulation.
3. The **Findings of Fact Conclusions of Law and Judgment** and **Marital Settlement Agreement** or **Proposed Marital Settlement Order** previously entered in the legal separation remains in effect without modification.

The parties are notified that:

It is unlawful for any person who is or has been a party to an action for divorce in any court in this state, or elsewhere, to marry again until 6 months after judgment of divorce is granted, and the marriage of any such person solemnized before the expiration of 6 months from the date of the granting of judgment of divorce shall be void.
