| Purpose of Form | To allow a parent who has been awarded periods of physical placement to seek enforcement of a physical placement order. |
| Who Completes It: | The party who seeks to enforce a physical placement order. This person shall be identified as the petitioner, regardless of whether that person was the petitioner or respondent in the underlying action. |
| Distribution of Form | Original to court, copies to petitioner for service on respondent. |
